ACT PREP - FALL ACADEMY CONQUER THE ACT

College Access Initiative is now offering affordable and relevant ACT test prep in a five-week class format. This team-taught class will focus on motivating strategies and a fresh approach to conquering the ACT. All four subject areas of the ACT – English, Math, Reading, Science Reasoning – will be covered. Juniors and seniors of all levels will benefit from this unique approach to test prep.

The class will begin with a parent-student orientation to start a broad conversation about the college planning process and to provide details about the program. The five-week class will include strategies to help students:

- *Discover the balance between speed and accuracy
- *Remove mental blocks that inhibit performance
- *Gain familiarity and confidence with the test format
- *Understand the role the test plays in the college planning process
- *Move toward realizing their true potential on the test
