- Must complete the Smart Core curriculum with a 2.5 GPA or minimum composite score of 19 on the ACT <u>OR</u> under Common Core graduation achieve at least a 2.5 GPA and a minimum composite score of 19 on the ACT <u>and</u> score proficient or higher on End of Course tests (Algebra I, Geometry, and Biology)
