

Crazy 4 Poker

Bet the Ante and matching Super Bonus and get five cards. The dealer also gets five cards, one of which may be an upcard (in one game version). You may fold or, if you think your best four-card hand is worthy, make a Play bet equal to your Ante (3x the Ante allowed with **AA** or better), settled as follows:

	If Dealer Qualifies (King-High or Better)	If Dealer Does Not Qualify
Ante	1:1 Win or Lose	Push
Play	1:1 Win or Lose	1:1 Win
Super Bonus	Win odds 200/30/15/2/1.5/1 for AAAA , 4-of-a-Kind, Str. Flush, 3-of-a-Kind, Flush, Straight	
	Less than Straight: Lose if dealer stronger	Less than Straight: Push

At -3.31% of a \$10 Ante, the expected loss is nearly \$12 per hour (35 hands) using the strategy below. With an upcard, the return is improved to -2.76%.

Always "Triple Down" with AA or better	
In game version with no upcard, Play only these: • KQ84 or better • the specific hand KQ765	
A up: AQ⁺ (AQ or better)	Q up: KQ9⁺
K up: KQ⁺	J, T up: KJT⁺
9-4 up: KQ⁺ or KJ&U (a hand containing King and Jack & a card that matches the Upcard)	
3 up: KQ⁺ or KJ&3 or KT&3	2 up: KJ⁺ or KT&2
