

Four Card Poker

Bet the Ante and get five cards, while the dealer gets six cards (one face-up). Then fold or make a Play bet from 1x to 3x your Ante. If your best four-card hand beats or ties the dealer's best four cards, you win 1:1 on all bets. There are Ante bonuses of 25/20/2 for 4-of-a-Kind/StraightFlush/3-of-a-Kind, even if your hand loses.

- 3x raise with any Two Pair or higher

If you have a Pair, follow these rules in order:

- 3x raise with:
 - JJ** or higher v. **A K Q J**, only if you have a match of the upcard, e.g., **QQK42** v. **K** up
 - TT** v. upcards **T** or less
 - 99** v. upcards **9 8 7 6 3 2** (not **4** or **5**)
- 1x call with any Pair that contains a match of the upcard, e.g., **22964** v. **6** up, **22QJT** v. **2**
- Fold **33** if you have a **2**; Fold **22** v. **3** thru **A**
- 1x call with any Pair not mentioned above

Fold if you have less than a Pair, except:

- v. **A K Q** up: 1x call with **AKQ8** or better
- v. **J** or less: 1x call if your hand has **AKQ** and a match of the upcard and a fifth card that is **8** or higher, e.g., **AKQ94** v. **4** up

A \$10 Ante at -2.84% (-3.12% if 30/15/2 bonuses) costs about \$9 per hour (30 hands) and \$11.68 more with \$10 on Aces Up (50/40/8/5/4/3/1).
