College Ready Summer 2012 Workshops Parking and Forms

Parking:

All participants staying in the dorms are issued one prepaid parking pass valid for the week of their workshop. Lost, stolen or destroyed parking passes are replaced at the cost of the participant. Parking passes and parking maps can be bought and viewed at http://parking.uark.edu/.

Staying on campus:

For those staying in the dorms, we recommend you park your car when you arrive in one of the authorized areas (listed below) and leave your car there until you depart. This permit authorizes parking in UA parking areas designated as FACULTY/STAFF (yellow); STUDENT (green); REMOTE (orange), Resident Reserved (red) and silver UA parking meters (you do not need to feed the meter). DO NOT PARK in the parking garage or at any GOLD meters. If you are issued a ticket while on campus you will be responsible for the fine. (Please see attached map)

Driving Daily:

For those driving each day, you will need to park in the Harmon Parking Garage. When you arrive each day you will need to pull a ticket from the machine and bring it to the workshop with you. There will be someone available in the morning (possibly on breaks) and at lunch tme to validate your tickets. It it between Duncan Avenue and Harmon Avenue on Williams Street. This is the only place you are authorized to park. If you are issued a ticket while on campus you will be responsible for the fine. (Please see attached map)

A completed copy of each of the forms below (except the w-9) will be given to you when you check in for your workshop. You will need to verify that everthing is correct, and sign and return them to me immediately.



What you will need to bring:


The following are items we will **NOT** provide:
