Crazy 4 Poker

Bet the Ante and matching Super Bonus and get five cards. The dealer also gets five cards, one of which may be an upcard (in one game version). You may fold or, if you think your best four-card hand is worthy, make a Play bet equal to your Ante (3x the Ante allowed with **AA** or better), settled as follows:
